About Us

Founded in 2000 by Speech-Language Pathologist, **Robin Seccafico**, Dynamic is a New York State Department of Health (DOH) approved Early Intervention (EI), Preschool & School-Age service provider, serving families in the **New York City boroughs, Orange, Rockland, Ulster & Dutchess County**.

The New York State Early Intervention Program

The **NYS Early Intervention (EI) Program** is part of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act. Under this law, infants and toddlers (**birth through age three**) are entitled to a wide range of rehabilitative services. The EIP is administered by the NY Department of Health (DOH) through the Bureau of Early Intervention.

Is My Child Eligible?

Eligibility for EI services is determined by New York State **approved EI evaluators** under contract with the municipality. Upon request, DYNAMIC can perform an EI evaluation for eligible EI children.

Where Are Services Provided?

EI services are provided where it's most natural & appropriate for the child such as their **home, daycare or another community setting**.

How Much Does It Cost?

All EI services are provided at **no cost** to parents. Health insurance or Medicaid may be accessed for reimbursement of services provided to eligible children & families.

How Do I Enroll My Child?

If you have concerns regarding your child's development or need help with a referral, simply call **DYNAMIC CENTER at 866-533-1020**.

EIP is a **voluntary & confidential** program. No private health information can be disclosed outside the scope of the program without written parental or guardian consent.

Private Pay Services

In addition to publicly funded services, DYNAMIC offers **private developmental or educational evaluations** as well as ongoing services such as **Speech, Occupational or Physical Therapy**.

Early Intervention Services

DYNAMIC contracts with NYC DOH & Mental Hygiene as well as Orange, Rockland, Dutchess & Ulster County DOH to provide the following EI services:

- **Screenings & Multi-Disciplinary Evaluations**
- **Home/Community-Based Interventions**
 - Occupational Therapy
 - Physical Therapy
 - Speech Therapy
 - Vision Therapy
 - Applied Behavior Analysis*
 - Special Instruction
 - Social Work Services

 - Special Instruction
 - Speech-Language
 - Parent-Child

Preschool & School-Age Services

In Orange & Rockland County, RCDS provides the following Preschool Services:

- **Speech-Language, Physical & Occupational Therapy**
- **Special Instruction (SEIT)**
- **Applied Behavior Analysis**

*Children must first be assessed & qualify for related services via their respective school district's **Special Education** program. The duration, frequency, and location of service are based on each child's Individualized Education Plan (IEP).*
